


## 2019 Colleen Cavin Fellowship Application

Focus on Books Arts (FOBA) offers the opportunity to work intensively with the conference staff in return for on-site lodging, food, and two days of class tuition. The work will take place alongside the conference committee members who have been working behind the scenes since the last conference, getting ready to make this conference an awesome success.
